Inclement Weather Policy – Approved March 2, 2015; Amended December 7, 2015

At Mi Escuelita, we make every effort to be open regardless of weather conditions. The safety of our staff members and our families is always of great concern to us, so we hope that you understand when we have to make adjustments to our schedule. Our Inclement Weather Policy is as follows:

In the event of inclement weather, we will evaluate the severity of road conditions and the ability for the necessary level of staff, based on state regulations, to safely reach the school.

A decision to delay opening or to close the school will be made as far in advance as reasonably possible, but by no later than 7:30 AM on the morning of the closing. We will send out an email with delay or closing information as early as possible. Please consult channels 5, 11 and 14 the evening prior and/or throughout the morning of for updated delay/closing information. You may also call Mi Escuelita in the morning and information regarding delays or closings will be available on our answering machine.

Please note that even if the school decides to remain open for any portion of the day, it is the responsibility of parents to evaluate road conditions in the areas where they live and exercise good judgment in deciding whether it is safe to transport children to the school.

Additionally, in the event it is ever necessary to close the school early owing to inclement weather, it is imperative that we have all contact numbers and email addresses on file and that they are up-to-date. If we need to close the school early due to worsening weather conditions, we must know how to contact you. Please make certain that we have the necessary information on file so that someone can be reached during the workday in the event we need to close.

For every five days of closure accumulated due to inclement weather, the school will provide one make-up day for up to total of three make-up days per fiscal year (September 1 – August 31). Dates of make-up days will be determined and announced as they become necessary.
